



Atlanta's First-Ever Epic Adoption Event Aims for 200 Animal Adoptions in a Single Day

April 25, 2015 (Atlanta, GA) – A first-of-its-kind event brings together animal welfare organizations from across the state for an epic animal adoption event.

“Meet Your Best Friend” will bring together 23 animal rescues and shelters for a one-day adoption event. The goal is to find forever homes for more than 200 adoptable cats, dogs, kittens and puppies.

Cal Morgan, President at CEO at Atlanta Humane Society says hosting the event only helps further the mission of the Atlanta Humane Society.

“As the state’s largest animal welfare agency, part of our role is to unite Georgia shelters and rescue groups in our common goal, and that is ending companion animal homelessness here.
