Animals Affected by Hurricane Joaquin Arrive in Atlanta

October 7, 2015 (Atlanta, GA) – As part of ongoing disaster relief efforts throughout the State of South Carolina, Animal Rescue Teams, including the Atlanta Humane Society, are assisting area animal shelters affected by Hurricane Joaquin.

The Lee County Animal Shelter in Bishopville is experiencing severe flooding on the property and damage to the roof. The Humane Society of the United States' Animal Rescue team is on the ground to assist the shelter and is transferring the animals to other HSUS Emergency Placement partners. 18 dogs have made their way to Atlanta Humane Society where they are expected to be available for adoption in the coming days.
