Chihuahuas Removed from Horrid Conditions

20 Chihuahuas are now in the care of the Atlanta Humane Society

Atlanta, GA (November 25, 2016) – This morning, the Atlanta Humane Society brought 20 Chihuahuas into our care after LaGrange Animal Services seized them from horrid conditions in a house with 34 other animals, including ferrets. The owner has been ticketed with multiple cases of animal cruelty and neglect.

LaGrange Animal Services were called to the home on Tuesday and asked the Atlanta Humane Society to assist with the care of the animals. Among the Chihuahuas AHS took into our possession were 2 moms and 9 nursing puppies who have been put into foster care for at least a month. The other dogs are receiving vet checks at the Mansell Campus of the Atlanta Humane Society in Alpharetta and will be placed up for adoption when they are cleared.
